

NECK SPECIFICATIONS

We use the finest necks available anywhere, custom made for us by Warmoth Guitar Products** in the USA. They are delivered with the fingerboards unslotted. Here in Sweden, using state-of-the-art CNC machining technology, we cut our unique curved fret slots and install the frets and the position markers.

Our necks are supplied in two different models - "Pro" and "Vintage Modern".



The Pro neck has a heel-adjust double expanding truss rod with Gotoh side-adjust mechanism. Note the fine-adjust screw on the treble side of the heel. No need to remove the neck to make minor relief adjustments, just loosen the strings and adjust the side adjust screw with the supplied Allen key.

Vintage Modern necks have a vintage single truss rod with adjustment at the head end, and a contrasting "skunk stripe" on the back of the neck. They are available both with separate "slab" fingerboard, and in one-piece maple (other woods by special order).

The Vintage Modern style neck also fits guitar bodies with non-standard neck screw placing, where one or more of the neck attachment screws would conflict with the side adjust screw on the Pro neck. (Fender® Jeff Beck Stratocaster®, some Ernie Ball® guitars, etc.)



Our necks fit bodies with neck pocket and bridge position adhering to industry standard Fender® Stratocaster® specifications, with no modifications. (They will also fit a "T" style body, but will leave small gaps in the corners of the neck pocket. These are hidden by the extended fingerboard.)
